The C.A.O. said Bylaw 08/19 – Rocky View County and M.D. of Bighorn Intermunicipal Development Plan is to set a policy framework for planning matters that includes future land use, environmental matters, transportation, and items of mutual interest as it applies to lands in proximity to the shared boundary and defined in the IDP Area. The IDP also contains policies that define how communication, cooperation, decision-making and dispute resolution shall occur for lands within the IDP Area.

Final Questions of Administration


Councillor Rosvold asked if the Hearing had been advertised appropriately. The C.A.O. said it had.
