

DISCOVER ART FEE SUBSIDY PROGRAM

1. Qualifying for the Discover Art Fund at artsPlace means you are eligible to access \$250.00/year/family member to apply towards art courses and workshops offered at artsPlace (the amount applied to any program may not exceed 75% of the total program/membership fee). Movies, special event screenings and live performances are not eligible for subsidy. Material fees not included in program fees are eligible for subsidy, please speak with a staff member for details on purchasing materials
2. Once your Discover Art application is complete and you have the supporting documentation in place, please drop it off at artsPlace, 950 8 Avenue, Canmore or scan and e-mail to info@artsplacecanmore.com. Please let us know which programs you are interested in taking when your application is dropped off (or include with the application) and we will put a place on hold for you.
3. You will be contacted within one week and an artsPlace representative will assist you with the registration process.
4. All applicants are required to re-apply annually (1 year to the day after approval) and provide current documentation.
5. If you have been declined and your financial situation has changed, you are welcome to reapply. There is no waiting period required.
6. The artsPlace Cancellation Policy applies to all programs accessed through the Recreation Fee Assistance program. Sales are final, but credits will be issued up to two weeks prior to the beginning of the program.
